APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Rilutek (riluzole) tablets, Tiglutik (riluzole) oral suspension may be approved when the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has with a diagnosis of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS);

OR

- II. Individual has diagnosis of chorea associated with Huntington disease (AAN 2012); **AND**
- III. Dosing is at or targeted for 200mg a day (AAN 2012).

Requests for Tiglutik (riluzole) oral suspension must also meet the following criteria:

- I. Individual is unable to swallow the oral tablet dose form due to a clinical condition such as but not limited to the following:
 - A. Dysphagia; **OR**
 - B. Individual's age.
