

Remote blood pressure and glucose monitoring for Medicaid-covered pregnant individuals

From the Georgia Department of Public Health, in partnership with Georgia's CMOs and Philips



In 2023, Georgia State Legislature passed the Healthy Mothers, Healthy Babies Act, funding remote patient monitoring to expectant individuals, at no cost to you or the patient.

All Medicaid members in the state of Georgia with clinical indications for maternal hypertension or maternal diabetes are eligible for this program.*

Philips Remote Perinatal Care supports remote patient management, triage, and health coaching during pregnancy and up to 90 days postpartum.



Device shipment and onboarding

We ship pre-configured, cellular-enabled devices directly to participants and help educate them on the devices to get started.



Professional monitoring

Our team of licensed practical nurses monitor readings 24/7, engage participants when alerted to out of range or missing readings, and escalate to providers when needed.




Personalized health coaching

Our team of RNs, dietitians and certified diabetes educators help participants set and achieve SMART health goals, manage risk factors, track weight, learn about medication, and manage stress.
