

Childhood Lead Prevention Project ECHO

The Childhood Lead Prevention Project ECHO® is a new six-month, quality improvement, MOC part 4* program. Focusing on central New Jersey counties (Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Somerset, and Union), this program aims to improve early identification and referral of children with elevated blood-lead levels to reduce the incidence of developmental disabilities in New Jersey children.

Launching in January 2023, this program will feature:

- Monthly sessions on the third Wednesday of the month from noon to 1 p.m.
- Mentoring and guidance from multi-disciplinary hub faculty.
- Quality improvement coaching.
- Progress tracking through personalized run charts.
- Monthly data submissions.
- Case-based and peer-to-peer learning.
