

EDI Gateway update

Amerigroup Community Care of New Mexico, Inc. has designated Availity* as a no-cost option to operate and service your electronic data interchange (EDI) entry point (or EDI Gateway). This designation will ensure greater consistency and efficiency in EDI submission.

Your organization can submit and receive the following transactions through Availity's EDI Gateway:

- 837 — institutional claims
- 837 — professional claims
- 837 — dental claims
- 835 — electronic remittance advice (ERA)
- 276/277 — claim status
- 270/271 — eligibility request
- 275 — electronic medical attachments
- 278 — prior authorizations and referrals
- 278N — inpatient admission and discharge notification

Get started with Availity:

- Use existing clearinghouse or billing vendor.
 - Work with your vendor to ensure connection to the Availity EDI Gateway.
- Become a direct submitter with the Availity EDI Clearinghouse.
 - A third-party practice or revenue cycle management system capable of generating EDI batch files is required.

Already have an Availity login, but want to submit EDI transactions?

1. Log in to Availity.
2. Select My Providers > Enrollments Center > Transaction Enrollment.
3. Follow the steps to enroll as a trading partner.

New to Availity and want to submit EDI transactions?

1. Choose an administrator to register your organization.
2. When the administrator is ready to register, choose the **register** button on the top of the page.
3. Select your organization type and complete the registration process.
4. Administrator should check email to verify account.

Electronic funds transfer (EFT) registration

To register or manage account changes for EFT only, use the secure electronic EFT registration platform **EnrollHub**,™ a CAQH Solutions.™ This enrollment tool eliminates the need for paper registration, reduces administrative time and costs, and allows you to register with multiple payers at a time.

ERA registration

Use Availity to register and manage account changes for ERA. If you were previously registered to receive ERA, you must register using Availity to manage account changes.
