New Behavioral Health Facilities grant application now open

\$6 million available targeting crisis stabilization

Thanks to a unique public-private partnership with Premera Blue Cross, the Department of Commerce currently has \$6 million in capital construction funding available for behavioral health facilities targeting crisis stabilization needs in rural communities in Washington state.

The Behavioral Health Facilities program has one competitive funding application open now for grants that will range from \$150,000 - \$1 million.

The Crisis Stabilization Grant **application closes on Dec. 28, 2020.**

Funding is open to nonprofits, public entities, Tribes and for-profit businesses. Nonprofit and for-profit business applicants must be registered in the State of Washington. All applicants must meet all applicable licensing and certification requirements under specific RCWs and WACs pertaining to the behavioral health services proposed in the facilities to which the funding will be applied. Grants are for reimbursement for capital projects only.
