



Treatment Initiation & Participation (TIP) Pilot:

Improving Antidepressant Medication Adherence and Depression Outcomes

WHAT

The Washington State Department of Health is seeking Behavioral Health Practitioners serving Spanish-speaking patients to pilot a brief behavioral health intervention. The Treatment Initiation and Participation Program has been designed and studied to help patients newly prescribed antidepressants to stay on their medications.

WHEN

The project will begin once 10 to 12 practitioners are recruited and go for approximately 90 days.

WHO

Behavioral Health Practitioners serving Spanish-speaking adults in a primary care or behavioral health setting.
