Is Your Clinic Losing Incentive Payments for Children's Well-Care Exam Rates?

If your clinic provides health care for children/adolescents and is losing an incentive payment for well-care visits, we may be able to help, and your clinic can earn up to \$10,000 in the process!

Washington State Department of Health, in partnership with the Medicaid Managed Care Organizations (MCOs), is sponsoring a Fall 2021 Clinic Project (August-December 2021 with final reporting in January 2022).

The goal of this project is to identify the clinic's rates for well-care exams for patients 0 to 21 years of age and increase the clinic's rates of well-care visits by using strategies utilized by successful clinics.

WHAT THE CLINIC WILL GET:

PARTNERS will work with MCOs to reconcile the list of patients attributed to the clinic (the list used to report the official rate of well-care visits for patients served).

EXPERIENCE using MCO's reports (Master Rosters, Care Gap Reporting & Add/Drop Reporting).

LEARN tips reported from other clinics as helpful and what parents say enable them to get well-care exams completed.

INCENTIVES are available upon completion of 5 tasks and vary based on the number of children attributed to the clinic and the number of partnering MCOs (1 or 2).

Up-to-date Panel Awareness can be maintained beyond the Fall 2021 Clinic Project





PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Serve at least 250 Medicaid managed care patients 0 to 21 yrs of age with one Medicaid MCO.
- Child/adolescent well-care visit rate is currently below the state average
- Clinic is willing to dedicate time and resources between August December 2021 and partner with one or two Medicaid MCOs to complete a series of five tasks to increase the rates of well-care exams for identified age groups. The final project report is due in January 2022 and a meeting with peer clinics to follow.
